SMWYC offers Introductory to Advanced classes for Coeds ages 7-16 through a variety of sessions. The workhorses of the program are US Sabots, a centerboard pram ideal for Marina del Rey. We also have a growing fleet of Optimist Prams, Lasers, CFJs, a C420 and offer keelboat sailing on our Santana 20.

The gate code to the parking lot gate is 123123. Check in begins at 8:45 and everybody should be checked in by 9:15. This Information Package is required for all students. If you have already completed this form for your child, please do not complete this form unless key Medical or Contact information has changed. **No child will be allowed to participate unless and until a valid Assumption of Risk form is completed.**

Please have students bring a properly fitted life jacket, water, shoes and Sunscreen daily. Also, please have your child bring a towel and dry clothes. All students are required to wear their life jackets when on the docks and in the boats. No video games please and cell phones are discouraged.

Most SMWYC Instructors are US Sailing certified level one sailing instructors, as well as CPR / First Aid certified. Instructors are trained on providing a fun and safe learning environment for your child.

SMWYC is committed to maintaining a safe and positive environment for its participants. A copy of our general rules and disciplinary policy is included in this package for both the parent and student to acknowledge and sign.

Liability Waiver, Release and Indemnification Agreement

Please Read Carefully

1. I, the undersigned, am a parent having legal custody/person having legal custody or guardian of the following minor:

2. I wish to voluntarily involve the above minor in the Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club Youth Sailing Program activities. In consideration of the minor's participation in this voluntary recreational activity and use of SMWYC equipment, I acknowledge and agree as follows:

To the fullest extent permitted by law, I promise not to sue, I forever release and agree to indemnify and hold harmless SMWYC from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, losses, costs and expenses including attorney fees, for personal injury to the minor or any other person and/or loss of any property, arising from the minor's participation in the sailing program and shore side activities and any active or passive negligence of SMWYC, such as negligent rescue.

4. I represent that the minor is in good health, is able to undertake sailing activities, and can swim well enough in the event his/her boat capsizes to avoid any resulting danger. I further represent that the minor is capable of comprehending instruction, following directions and observing proper safety precautions. I agree to abide by the decisions of the SMWYC Board of Directors if he/she finds it necessary to discipline or dismiss the minor for lack of attention misbehavior or failure to follow safety precautions.

5. For the purpose of the Agreement, SMWYC shall include its directors, officers, employees, agents, and committee persons of any of them. If any term of this Agreement is held invalid, the remaining terms shall continue in full force and effect. This Agreement shall survive the termination of the minor's participation in SMWYC Youth Sailing Program activities.

By signing below, I certify that I have carefully read and fully understand this agreement. I am aware that this is a broad release of liabilities and indemnity agreement and I sign of my own free will without any inducement or assurance of any kind.

Junior Program Rules & Discipline Policy: Signature Form

1. No students on docks without supervision and a life jacket
2. Life jackets must be worn and secured at all times on docks, piers, boats, or in the water
3. Closed toed footwear to be worn at all times
4. No running or swimming (except with the permission of the instructors)
5. Students are not allowed on coach boats except as authorized by an instructor
6. No jumping on to or off of boats
7. Respect one another – no physically or verbally abusive behavior is allowed
8. Use respectful language – no swearing, foul, or rude language
9. No littering on land or water
10. Students must stay with the rest of the class at all times
11. All sailors must make an effort to sail out and return to docks together
12. Prior to drills, all boats must stay within hailing distance of the safety/coach boat
13. All coach boats and junior sailboats must return to the dock prior to sunset
14. No destruction of club, Anchorage 47 and/or private property
15. All Anchorage 47 rules must be obeyed at all times
16. No smoking, drugs or alcohol
17. No playing on or near ramps and hoists
18. No playing with boom, hoist or crane
19. Watch fingers and feet between boats, docks, and moving parts
20. Club owned boats must be properly returned and put away after use
21. Sailors must make every effort to avoid collisions

Discipline Policy:

1. First Strike: Student will be warned and student's file will be noted.

2. Second Strike: Student will be warned and parent/guardian will be informed and asked to meet with the Program Director. The strike and meeting notes will be noted in student's file.

3. Third Strike: The student will be asked to sit out for the rest of the day. Parent/guardian will be informed and asked to meet with the Program Director. Strike will be documented in the student's file.

4. Continued Abuse: Continued abuse of the rules will result in expulsion from the program. Parent/guardian and the Program Director will be informed. No fee will be refunded.
