NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

Boats must be a minimum of 20 feet LOA.

Boats must be equipped per PHRF Category 3 requirements.

PHRF and ORCA minimum crew - 3. Cruisers minimum crew - 2.

ELIBIGILITY and ENTRY FEES

Members of SCYA Yacht Clubs, holding valid PHRF or ORCA ratings and all Cruiser racers are invited to participate in a race from Channel Islands Harbor to Marina del Rey Harbor on Saturday, June 29, 2013.

The entry fee is \$45, (\$40 for US Sailing members), if received at Channel Island Yacht Club by 1800 hours Thursday, June 27, 2013. Entries will be accepted up to 0800 hours, Saturday, June 29th; with a \$10 surcharge.

Course

From the start at Channel Islands, all classes will round Oil Platform "GINA" and go down the coast to Marina Del Rey for a handicap distance of **46 NM**.

CLASSES and SCHEDULE

Classes are available in PHRF, Cruiser Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker, and ORCA.

A minimum of four (4) entries will establish a class as determined by entries received by 0800 on Saturday, June 29th.

The first Warning Signal is scheduled for 1055 hours on Saturday.

HANDICAP RATINGS

PHRF and ORCA Base Off-wind ratings will apply. Cruising Class boats will be assigned ratings by the Race Committee using generic PHRF Base Off-wind Ratings, adjusted by the rating factors listed on the Entry Form.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the ChIYC and SMWYC web sites by 1800 hours, Wednesday, June 27th. Classes, Order of Starts and any Amendments will be posted at Channel Islands Yacht Club by 0900 hours, Saturday, June 29th.

MANDATORY SKIPPER'S MEETING

A representative of each boat is required to meet in the ChIYC dining room at 0900 hours on Saturday, June 29th to review any posted notices and resolve any unclear points.

TROPHIES

Trophies will be presented at SMWYC on Sunday, June 30th, at 1100 hours.

2-3 Boats - One Trophy; 4 Boats - Two Trophies; 5 or more Boats - Three Trophies

Perpetual Trophies:

PHRF First to Finish: *Perpetual Trophy*

PHRF Corrected Time: *Bud Verplank Trophy*

Club with the most entries: *Ray Russell Trophy*

Two additional trophies will be displayed, based on the total corrected time in this race and the following MdR to San Diego race.

PHRF: The YRU-SC "Schooner America".

Cruiser: *Down the Coast Trophy*.

Friday, June 28 The bar at ChIYC will open at 1600 hours. ChIYC will host its famous pre-race steak dinner for \$15.00 at 1830 hours. Advance dinner reservations are encouraged, and can be made on the Race Entry form, if filed by 1700 hours, Thursday, June 27th.

Saturday, June 29 ChIYC will serve a breakfast frittata with fruit, etc from 0800 to 0900 hours, for a cash price of \$8.00.

After the Race SMWYC will serve hot chili and no-host beverages at the bar, until midnight.

Sunday, June 30 SMWYC will host a tasty country-style breakfast from 0800 to 1000 hours, for a cash price of \$8.00.
