NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
The Lido-14 Class Association is the Organizing Authority.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all eligible juniors sailing a properly measured Lido 14 boat.
Entries may be made online through Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club (www.smwyc.org) or by completing an entry, waiver and parental consent form (available from Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club and the Lido 14 Class Association www.lido14.com) and sending it, fully executed, with the required fee made payable to and mailed to:

FEES. The entry fees for this regatta are \$20 if entered on line prior to August 1, 2013, \$30.00 per boat if the application is received on August 1, 2013 or later.

REGATTA SCHEDULE: Up to five races are scheduled with one race required to constitute a regatta.

0900 to 1000 – Late Registration:

1000 – Competitors Meeting

1227 – Warning signal for Race 1, additional races to follow

1700 – Trophies and Awards

MEASUREMENTS. Measurements required to be completed for each boat competing are as follows:

Crew weights in normal sailing attire are to be completed at registration. Minimum combined crew weight to be 200 lbs.

Each boat shall provide a copy of the valid measurement certificate completed prior to final registration for the event.

Copies of the valid measurement certificate are acceptable may be mailed with the entry and entry fees.

Sails must have class royalty and measurer's stamp

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS. The sailing instructions and diagram of courses and course marks will be available no later than the end late registration.

RACING AREA. Races will be held in Santa Monica Bay approximately ½ mile west of the detached breakwater. In the event conditions dictate, the racing area may be moved to the outer channel of Marina del Rey inside the detached breakwater.

COURSES. Courses will be windward – leeward, lengths will be adjusted to accommodate existing conditions.

SCORING. The Low Point Scoring system, Appendix A2 *RRS* will apply except that each boat's score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

SAFETY REGULATIONS. Competitors are required to wear, while on the water, other than for a brief period while adding or removing clothing, a US Coast Guard (or Canadian) approved PFD.

LAUNCHING. A hoist is available at Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club as well as Del Rey Yacht Club and South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club who are also participating in the Lido 14 Championship Week.
