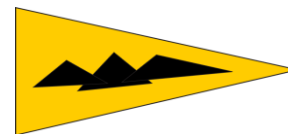

## Channel Islands to Marina del Rey Race

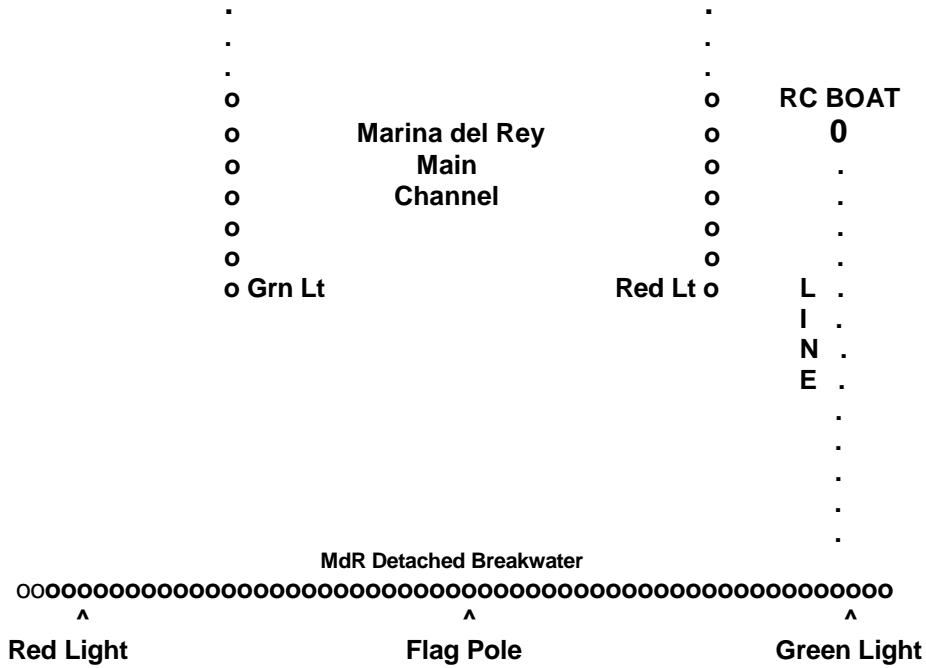
### Sailing Instructions

1. **RULES:** The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. In encounters with a non-racing vessel, racers shall comply with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS).
2. **ENTRIES:** Entries must be received by the Channel Islands YC Race Committee prior to 0800 hours, Saturday, June 29, 2013. Entries should be mailed to ChIYC, Attn: Race Committee, 4100 Harbor Blvd. Oxnard, CA 93035
3. **NOTICES TO COMPETITORS & CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Notices and changes will be posted on the official ChIYC notice board within 15 minutes after adjournment of the Skipper's Meeting.
4. **EQUIPMENT and INSPECTIONS:** All boats must carry current legal registration and meet USCG requirements. All boats must meet PHRF Category 3 requirements. Boats are subject to inspection before or after the race. *Radar reflectors at spreader height are recommended.*
5. **HANDICAP RATINGS:** Boats entered in PHRF classes shall have current certification of their Offwind Course (OWC) Base rating. Ratings for Cruiser class entries shall be determined by using generic Offwind Course (OWC) Base rating and the factors listed in the Notice of Race. These ratings will be assigned prior to the race, are final and may not be appealed.
6. **PRE-START CHECK IN:** Competitors must check in at the Channel Islands YC at a **mandatory** Skipper's Meeting to be held at ChIYC starting at 0900 hours on Saturday, June 29, 2013 **and also** at the R/C boat on station, before the first Warning Signal. Any boat that does not properly check in may be scored Did Not Start (DNS)
7. **START and START SCHEDULE:** Races will be started using *RRS 26*. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1055 hours. Classes, class signals and start schedule will be posted on the ChIYC notice board following the skipper's meeting.  
The Starting Line will be between the Mandalay Buoy (approximately 34° 12.00' N, 119° 16.50' W) and an orange flag on the RC boat.  
Any boat that does not start within **15** minutes of it's starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS).
8. **RECALLS and PREMATURE STARTS:** Recalls will be signaled in accordance with *RRS 29*. The Race Committee will attempt to hail sail numbers and/or yachts names verbally and/or on **VHF Ch 68**. Failure to hear a notification shall not be grounds for redress.

9. **START PENALTIES:** A boat crossing to the course side of the starting line after its preparatory signal but before its start signal and failing to return and make a proper start shall have a one-half (1/2) hour time penalty added to its elapsed time.-
10. **COURSE:** Leave all course marks to port.
- Start Line All Classes
  - Oil Platform “Gina” (34° 07.03’ N, 119° 16.61’W), including all associated buoys or vessels.
  - Pass to seaward of the MdR Detached Breakwater.
  - Finish Line – Between the MdR Detached Breakwater South End Light (Green) & Orange Flag on the Race Committee boat Inside the Breakwater.
  - The handicap distance is 46 NM.
11. **FINISH: See Finish Line Chart** The finish line will be between the Green Light on the South end of the detached Marina del Rey breakwater and an Orange flag on the RC boat. The Race Committee will display lights after sunset.
- Advise the Race Committee on **VHF Ch 71** when you are within a predictable time of finishing (approximately 15 minutes). Note your finish time and the identity of nearby boats. Complete your Finish Report and file it at SMWYC after docking.
  - If the Race Committee boat is not on station, take your own finish time based on GPS time when the Green Light bears 230°M — **Don’t forget your Finishing Report.**
  - Watch for the red shoal buoys off the southerly breakwall when entering the harbor.
12. **TIME LIMIT:** The time limit for all boats to finish is 0300 hours on Sunday, June 30<sup>th</sup>. Boats not finished by this time will be scored DNF.
13. **RETIREMENT:** A boat retiring before finishing must notify Santa Monica Windjammers YC at 310.827.7692 or the Finish Line RC boat on **VHF 71**. A boat retiring and failing to make this notification may jeopardize acceptance of its entry in future races and may be held responsible for search and rescue expenses.
14. **PROTESTS:** Protests must be filed at SMWYC by 0900 hours on Sunday June 30<sup>th</sup>. Protest forms are available at SMWYC. Notices of Protest hearings will be posted on the SMWYC Race Board. Efforts will be made to resolve protests promptly.
15. **SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, *RRS* Appendix A4, will be used.
